## FRIDAY NIGHT MADNESS Waukesha South 3 on 3 Basketball Rules

1. **Team Size:** Each team may have a maximum of four players and a minimum of three.
2. **Scoring:** All baskets made on or inside the 3 pt. arc are worth 1 point. Shots made outside the arc are worth 2 points. Games are played to 11 points (win by 2 or more) or to 15 (first team to 15 wins). See next rule for exceptions.
3. **Length of Game:** If not to 11 or 15 after 15 minutes, the team with the most points will be declared the winner. If the score is tied, “sudden death” free throw shooting will determine the winner.
4. **Fouls:** Floor monitors will call ALL fouls.
  1. Non shooting fouls result in possession given back to the team until the 7<sup>th</sup> foul at which point a free throw is awarded on any foul on and after the 7<sup>th</sup> team foul.
  2. Shooting fouls: When a basket is made, count the basket and after free throw, ball goes to the defense whether or not the free throw was made. When basket is missed, if the free throw is made, possession goes to the defense. If the free throw is missed the offense maintains possession. Note: Only one free throw is awarded for a shooting foul regardless of if shot is made or missed or if it was a one or two point shot.
  2. Non-Shooting fouls: ball given back to team at top unless it is 7 or more fouls in which free throws are given then.
  4. Technical Fouls: The first technical foul for a player will result in an automatic point and possession for the opposite team. A second technical foul for the same player in the same game will result in the same AND the player ejected from the tournament Any taunting or trash talking, unsportsmanlike conduct or flagrant fouls may result in a technical foul given by the floor monitor. A technical foul can also be called on any “coach” or fan. If this happens the other team will be awarded 2 points and the ball. The court monitor may also call a technical foul if a team is stalling with the intention of preserving a winning margin. This is a style of play in which the team in possession of the ball makes no attempt to advance the ball to the basket. The court monitor will make all these calls. Their decision is final and cannot be appealed.
5. **Opening possession:** Rock/Paper/Scissors. Held balls or ‘jump’ balls will be awarded to the Defensive team.
6. **Check and Passed in** – Can dribble or pass in to play but ball must be checked. Check outside the 3 pt. line.
7. **Change of Possession:** The ball will change possession after all scored baskets unless a foul is called. There is no “make it, take it” rule. On each change of possession, the ball must be taken back outside the three point arc at any point for the possession to legally begin. This must occur whether or not a shot was attempted. Failure to take it back results in loss of possession and loss of any points scored during the illegal possession. Taking it back means a person’s whole body and the ball must be behind the 3 pt. line.
8. **Substitutions:** Player changes may be made only during a dead ball situation.
9. **Game Times:** Game times will start at every 25 minutes. Games are 15 minutes and the next teams are given 5 minutes to warm-up.
10. **Use of Illegal Players:** The players listed on the team information form are the only players eligible to play on that team. Roster substitutions will not be allowed after “TEAM CHECK IN” prior to the tournament. Any team using a player that is not properly registered will be disqualified from the tournament.
